William J. “Fuzzy” Fuzi, a Gold Legacy Life Member of the Cedar Creek Memorial VFW Post 4376 in Seven Points, Texas, and was appointed in June 2021 as the State Deputy Inspector by State Commander Norman Macey at the 101st Department of Texas VFW State Convention held in Durant, Oklahoma.

Comrade Fuzi joined the VFW as an annual member in 1992 after his discharge from the United States Marine Corps and returning from the Gulf War. He joined Cedar Creek Memorial Post 4376 in Seven Points, Texas, in 2015-2016. He served as a Post Trustee, Post Junior Vice Commander, and as Post Commander.

In District 30, he held the positions of District Junior Vice Commander, Senior Vice Commander, and District Commander. At the State level, he held the position of VAVS Deputy Representative for North Texas (2019-2021).

He earned All-State and All-American Post Commander in 2019-2020, and 2020-2021. In 2020-2021, he earned All-State and All-American District Commander. In June 2021, he was awarded the Mack Johnson Award for having all District 30 Posts at 100% membership. Comrade Fuzi also was appointed National Aide-De-Camp 2020-2021.

Comrade Fuzi served in the United States Marine Corps from 1989 to 1991. He earned the Combat Action Ribbon, Southwest Asia Service Medal 2nd award, Kuwait Liberation Medal, Kuwait Liberation Medal (Saudi Arabia), and the National Defense Service Medal.
