7. Patriot Day, September 11th:

Per Presidential Proclamation, September 11th, is designated as "Patriot Day." The President requests the flag of the United States to be flown at half-staff (sunrise to sunset) and a moment of silence observed in honor of the individuals who lost their lives on that day due to terrorist attacks on the United States.

8. National POW/MIA Recognition Day, September 18th:

10.**Post Audits:** The 4th Quarter Post Audit Report (for the 2019-2020 Administrative year) were due by July 31, 2020 on Trustee's Audit forms. The (original) signed copy should have been mailed or emailed to Department of Texas VFW Headquarters. Deadline dates for Post Audits for the 2020-2021 Administrative Year:

1st Quarter Post Audit Report due by October 31, 2020

2nd Quarter Post Audit Report due by January 31, 2021

3rd Quarter Post Audit Report due by April 30, 2021

- 11.**Proof of Eligibility of elected and appointed positions:** Deputy State Inspectors will be reviewing all proof of eligibility for all elected and appointed positions during their scheduled visits to Posts and Districts.
- 12.**Post Inspections:** Post inspections will only be done by one of the following: District Commander, District Senior Vice Commander or District Junior Vice Commander.
- 13. Deadline to register Post and District Service Officers & Quartermaster Bond Application for Posts and Districts: September 1, 2020 was the due date to be submitted to Department of Texas VFW Headquarters.
- 14. Deadline to receive Veteran Project Participation Report (VPR) for Operation Iraqi Freedom: September 30, 2020 is the due date for the VPR for Operation Iraqi Freedom to be submitted to Department of Texas VFW Headquarters.
